1 Cor 7:28 For those who marry will face many **troubles** in this life.

Genesis 3:11-13 And he said, “Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree that I commanded you not to eat from?” The man said, “The woman you put here with me—she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it.” Then the LORD God said to the woman, “What is this you have done?” The woman said, “The serpent deceived me, and I ate.”

Psalm 84:6-7 and 11-12

Study Questions

Monday:

Tuesday:

Kevin and Jann talked about relational trouble. How can you view troubles as an opportunity to grow your relationship(s)? Whose voice are you listening to? Gen 3:11-13

How are you doing about trusting others with the messy parts of your life? Read Psalm 84. The Psalmist says, "they go from spring to spring." What are the valleys that you need refreshment in?

Thursday:

Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-12. Who is it that helps you stay grounded, anchored in trusting God's plan for your life? What is an area that needs to be strengthened?

Friday:

You are fearfully and wonderfully made. Psalm 139:14
You shall be my treasured possession Exodus 19:5
You are His glorious inheritance Ephesians 1:18
You are precious and honored in my eyes Isaiah 43:4
